Imagine over 600 guests gathered together in the WMU Bernhard Center's ballroom on Saturday August 12<sup>th</sup> 2017. There are 100 chef stations around the perimeter of the room, all manned by local men – centers of influence in our community – serving their favorite dish and earning tips (donations) from all of those guests. Cocktails are being served, a silent auction is taking place and everyone is having a great time raising money for the Boys and Girls Club of Kalamazoo.

Since 2009, "100 Men Who Cook" has been Old National Bank's signature fundraising event, relying heavily on the volunteer efforts of ONB associates - and the collaborative spirit of our local communities - for its great success.
